

11+ APPLICATION & PROCE

- Make a list of target schools
- Verify catchment rules on school's* website
- Read school's admission & test requirement
- Fill out each school's application form(s)
- Submit the form(s), complete registration
- Submit accompanying documents, if required
- Make a note of important dates*
- Go to open day of school(s) with child
- Use mix & variety of books/online platforms
- Let your child take 2/3 mock tests
- Use school/board-specific papers at home
- Make a focused plan to cover knowledge gaps
- If required, work with an experienced/ reliable tutor or sign up for a short course
- Give enough breaks between work
- Increase the difficulty level of test papers as you progress through the summer
- Review test papers together with child
- Make a list of challenging topics and areas
- Work on weak areas and record improvement
- Go out for walks and short outings; always reward and praise your child
- Take the test(s)!

School*- Check if the school your child is taking the test for is part of a consortium. A consortium is a group of schools which share a common entrance exam. Examples are the London 11+ Consortium and the South West Herts Consortium.

Important dates*- can be test/second-round test dates, result dates and open days.
